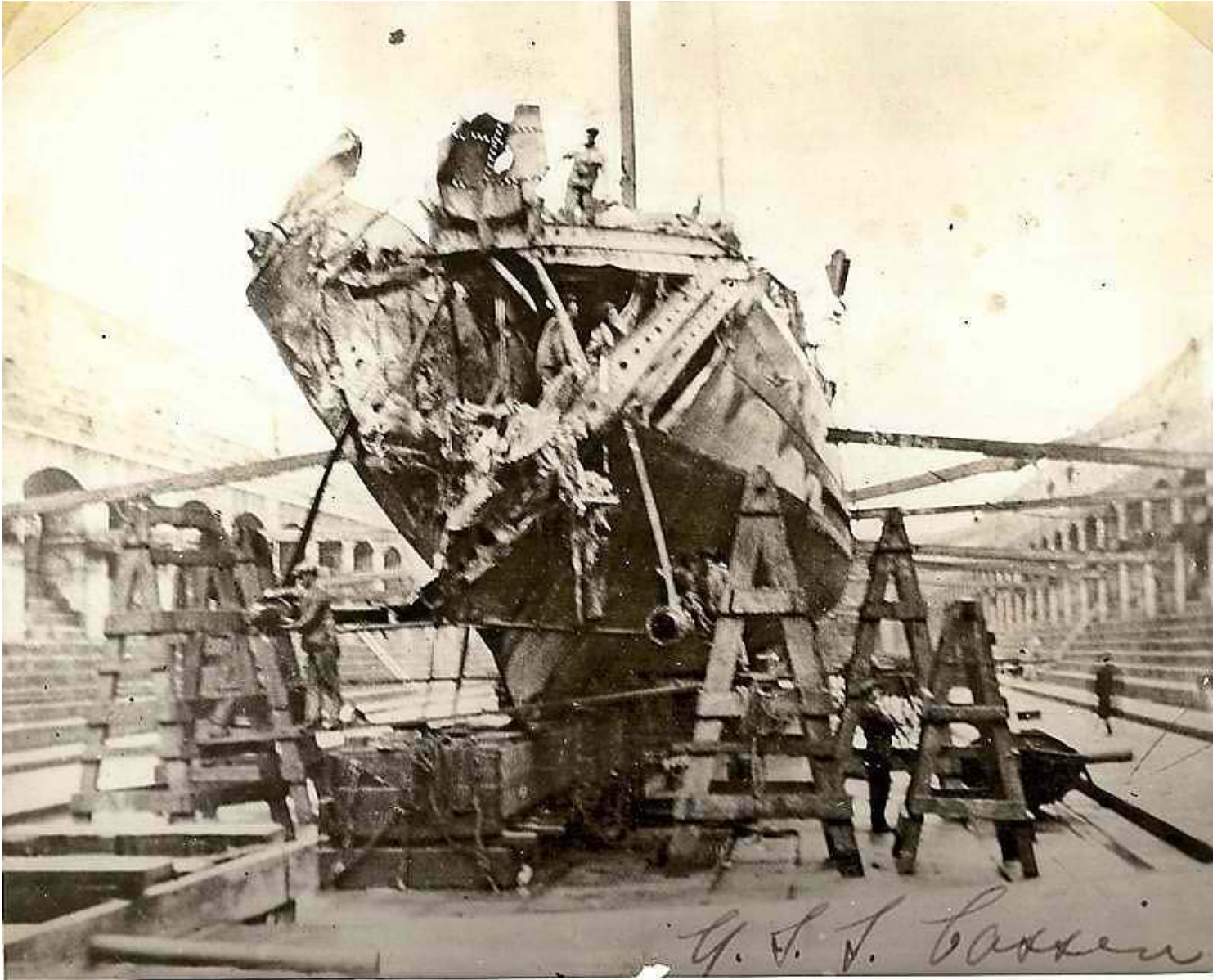


TRIBUTE TO O.K. INGRAM



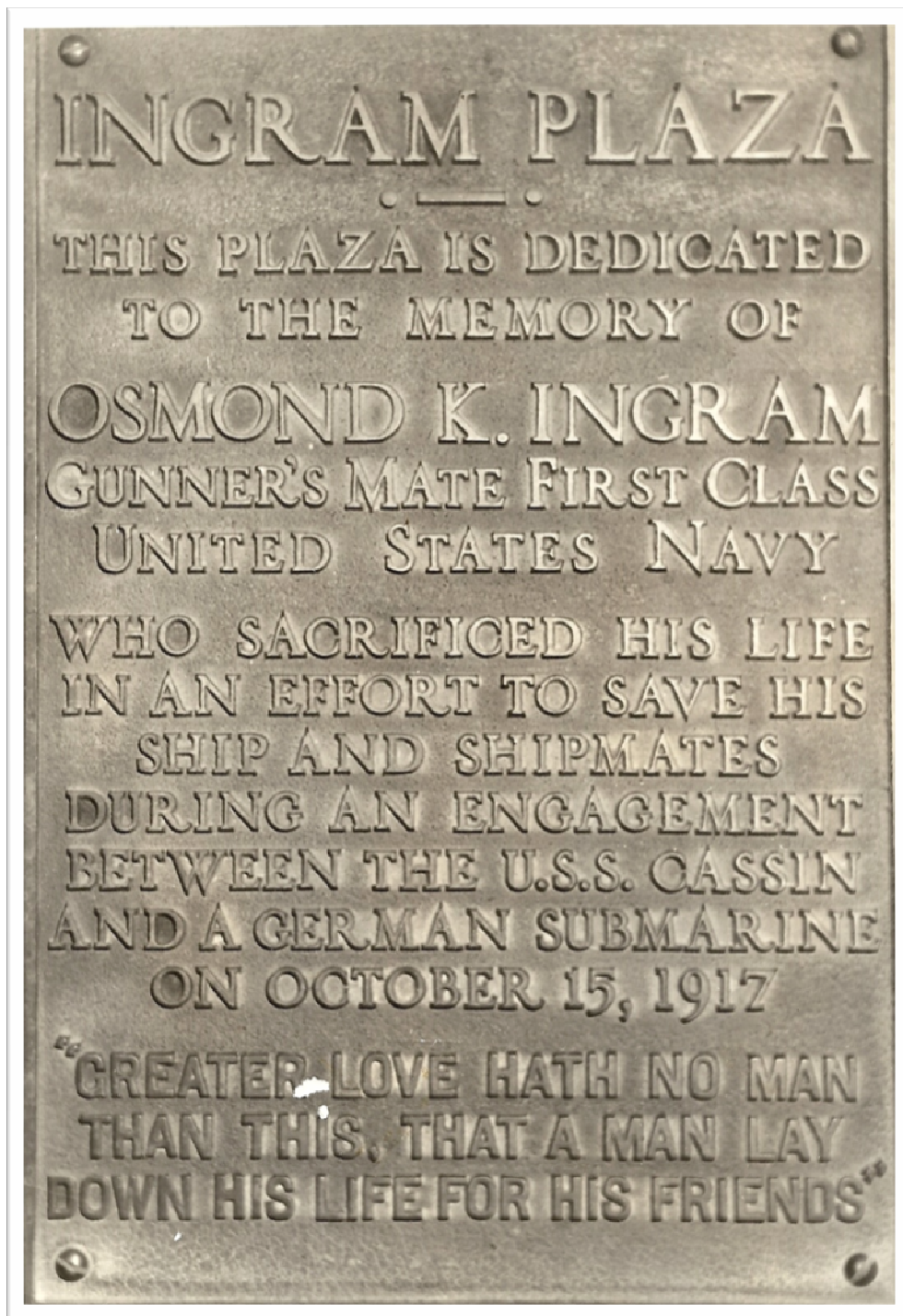
USS Cassin (DD-43) battle damage from the German torpedo



Rear Admiral Walter Vernon, Commander Battleship Division 13, U.S. Fleet was the Commanding Officer of USS Cassin (DD-43) when she was torpedoed 15 Oct 1917. The Admiral placed a wreath on the Ingram Memorial at Naval Training Station, San Diego, 16 Oct 1941. At this time, there were four crewmembers of the USS Cassin stationed at the Naval Training Station who were present for the ceremony
